I can't guarantee nothing else will trigger you in these books because triggers can be very individual, but these are the ones I thought might be an issue. That's the best I can do. I hope it helps!

All my books are kinky and all of them have spanking, punishments, and D/s relationships so I don't feel like I need to list that in any case.

As they are romance all books end with at least a HFN if they are in a series, or a HEA.

Gifted Affinities (Paranormal/ Ghost&Medium)

**Tropes:** Forced Proximity, Doomed Love (though there is a HEA in book two), Paranormal Romance, Virgin Because of Circumstances

Timeless Love (Paranormal/ Time Travel)
<b>Tropes:</b> Fated Love, White Knight/Hero, Broken Heart Rebound, Evil Ex, Love Transcends Time.
<b>Possible triggers:</b> Being dumped leading to depression and dangerous behavior. (Early in first book)

□Nothing But Time
□No Time Like the Present
<b>Daddy Takes the Reins</b> (Contemporary/ Cowboy/ Daddy kink with no ageplay or Littles)
Tropes: Second Chance Romance, Meddling Parent(s), Daddy Kink, Childhood Friends to Lovers, Commitment Issues, Complicated Inheritance.
Possible triggers: They are a RACK (Risk Aware Consensual Kink) couple who do not use safewords during punishment, by the <b>submissive's choice</b> and request. Death of a parent, grief.

□ Daddy Takes the Reins Box Set (includes books 1-4 which are a complete story arc)

Rough Daddy (Contemporary/ Cowboy/ Daddy) Spin-off of Daddy Takes the Reins

Tropes: Rugged Cowboy, Stubborn Woman Who Needs Help, Daddy Kink, Trust Issues, Small Town Romance, Just Passing Through, Experienced Dom/ inexperienced sub.

Possible triggers: Aftermath of parent death as well as memories of the complicated familial relationship, money stress.  □ The Trouble with Cowboys − Prequel (2024)
☐ Learning the Ropes (2024)
Action Daddy (Contemporary/ Daddy/DDlg)
Tropes: DDlg, Littles, Non-sexual Ageplay, Doesn't Trust Those Guys, Been Hurt Before, Secret Romance, Age-gap Romance (10 years).
Possible Triggers: Ageplay (non-sexual). At the end of book one we discover Olivia is a single mother, abandoned by the father, which is why she has trust issues.
□Lights, Camera, Daddy!
□Revenge of the Daddy!
□The Daddy Returns
□Wrath of Daddy Specific triggers: Misunderstandings and insecurities on Olivia's part about dealing with a long-distance relationship leads to a brief breakup, which Mitch quickly resolves.
The Krampus Collective (Holiday/ Paranormal)
<b>Tropes:</b> Krampus, Paranormal Romance, For Your Own Good, Holiday Romance, Monster/Mythological Creature Romance, Big Bad Magical vs. Ordinary Human, Interspecies Romance.
Possible triggers: Follows Krampus lore, including NC punishment and kidnapping.
□Daddy Krampus Specific trigger: non-sexual ageplay
□Krampus Sir
□Krampus Doms (MFM)
□Lord Krampus Specific trigger: has reference to human trafficking on the part of the villain.
□Krampus Zaddy

□Master Krampus Specific triggers: CNC. Unlike most of the other women in this series, she agrees to be entirely his up front, even though she doesn't know what he is. He holds her to that right from the start.
In the other books the punishment is non-con, as is the kidnapping, but the sex is usually initiates by the woman or clearly consensual.
With this one the lines are drawn differently. She knew she was agreeing to sex as part of the original deal, so he doesn't wait. It <i>is</i> clear she enjoys everything he does to her, including some degradation/humiliation, choking, etc.
He allows her to think her agreement was binding and permanent, when it wasn't. She has the same choice all the women do once the year is up, and she can say no to being his mate. He only lets her know this at the end of the year and it leads to a brief break-up, which is fixed for the happy ending.

Tropes: DDlg, Little/Middle girl, Age-Gap, Testing limits.
Possible Triggers: Aside from Ageplay/Daddy nothing I can think of.

### **Stand-alone books:**

 $\square$  Mastering Amari – originally named Enslaved by Magic. (Paranormal/Contemporary)

**Tropes:** Forced Proximity, Cursed Heroine, Paranormal Romance, The Power of Love, Secret Baby, Trapped by Circumstances, Tragic Past, Afraid to Lose Her.

**Possible triggers:** Amari is a genie doomed to be owned by whoever owns her bottle and must obey—her past is dark and filled with abuse but most of it is heavily implied and not detailed. That being said everything still manages to be pretty consensual with her love interest.

□ Architect of His Desire (Contemporary/ Office)
Tropes: Office Relationship, Boss/Employee,
Possible Triggers: The opening scene appears to be non-consensual sexual harassment until context is applied.
Shared World Series
<b>Master of the Zodiac</b> (A contemporary paranormal romance shared world series.) The books are stand-alone and each one is written by a different author. There will be some minor interactions between books as part of the shared world.
□ Scorpio – Book Two
<b>Tropes:</b> Dark Secrets, Second-Chance Romance, Hidden Past, Sworn Off Relationships, Revenge Against Ex, Starting Over, Trying Again, Avoiding Destiny, Avoiding Fate, Rejecting the Call, Can't Fight Fate, Betrayal, Lovers Forced to Opposite Sides, Outside Forces Tearing Them Apart
<b>Possible triggers:</b> The tropes make this sound darker than it is.  The relationship starts under a false pretense because Natalie was sent to make Cole fall for her. They are rivals for a special destiny, but he's not aware of it. She is. Lots of secret keeping but only on her side.
The feelings turn real for her too almost immediately, however, and she eventually ends up trapped in her lies and has to leave Cole abruptly, breaking his heart.  Years later he finds her in a volunteer slave auction and buys her contract with the intent to get his revenge and he is cold and a little cruel at first, but it doesn't last long.
Some war/death scenes. They are brief and not too graphic, but he is an ex-soldier.
Threats of public humiliation. (turn-on for her)
<b>Stateside Doms</b> (A contemporary series with stand-alone books that take place in each state)
☐ Her Wicked Rhode Island Dom
<b>Tropes:</b> Learning to trust again, The Atoner, Reluctant Hero, Rescue romance, Afraid to Commit, Scars from the Past, Right Person Wrong Time, Protective Dom/stubborn sub, Misunderstanding/jumping-to-conclusions, Grumpy except with her, Helping Her Start Over

**Possible triggers:** There are a lot here. The book starts off with them enjoying the happy ending, in order to make the traumatic parts easier when we go back to see how it all started. It does discuss some heavy subjects. I don't think the book overall is *too* dark, but it definitely is in places.

Alcohol abuse/addiction by MC (past tense, he has been sober for years) A terrible mistake in the past caused by drinking.

Physical, mental, and emotional abuse by a (fake) ex-Dom to the heroine (Nora). We see some of this on screen during a BDSM scene in a club. He berates her, physically crosses her boundaries, and ignores her safeword leading the club owner (Clint) to step in.

Later the same fake Dom dumps her in the parking lot for embarrassing him by safewording, and Clint is there to help her.

There is a conversation about how she blames herself and puts herself down for allowing the abuse to continue and they have a discussion about victim blaming and how wrong it is to do that. Like many people Nora wasn't able to understand why a woman would stay and endure that... until it happened to her.

"I would never let that happen to me!" is what everyone thinks, but it can and does happen. I consider this scene very important because it's something I've seen play out many times, but it might be painful to read for someone who has been abused.

**Rawhide Ranch** (A contemporary, multi-author series that takes place on a BDSM ranch. Ageplay, Littles, and DDlg are very popular in this series.

☐ Heaven Leigh's Little Halloween

**Tropes**: DDlg, Escaping Her Past, Help, I'm Stuck!, Getting a New Start, Lonely Among People (feels like she doesn't fit in), Second Chance Romance (for him), Practically a Virgin (her).

**Possible triggers**: DDlg, Littles, Ageplay (If those are triggers for you, I would avoid the series) Heaven Leigh escaped from a conservative religious family who kept her isolated and emotionally abused. As a teen on the streets she was 'adopted' by a wonderful older woman who gave her a new life. Heaven is now dealing with that woman's death and has run away to Rawhide Ranch to escape her grief.

Heaven Leigh thinks the answer to her problem is escaping into a childhood headspace, but she finds herself unable to be a Little all the time. Unlike the other Littles who seem happy with the restrictions placed on them... she doesn't feel like she belongs. This leads her to acting out.

That's when she crosses paths with Angel and we find out he's a widower with a sad story
about his first wife. He is just beginning to be ready to look at other women, and there is
chemistry between them.

## Sadie Marks

#### Rise of the Sadecs (Sci-Fi/ Alien abduction)

**Tropes:** Interspecies Romance, Alien Abduction, Non-standard Mating, Mars Needs Women/Men (In this case gender is irrelevant), Official Couple, Special Mating Needs, Bizarre Alien Biology

**Possible triggers:** The Sadec used to kidnap humans, but now they have a deal for volunteers. They have not returned the humans they took before though, so the series includes a mix of humans who volunteered and some who were outright kidnapped and stolen away by the Sadec race. There is quasi-C and NC.

The Sadecs believe in sharing what they treasure most, that includes their humans. Public punishment, sometimes harsh punishment.
